



LIABILITY RELEASE and CODE OF CONDUCT

I, the undersigned, acknowledge and agree to the following as a participant in the Riley Orton Foundation's volunteer trip to Kenya 2025;

Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability :

I understand and accept that participating in the volunteer trip involves inherent risks, including but not limited to, travel-related accidents, exposure to infectious diseases such as COVID 19 and malaria, or death which may be caused by forces of nature, the negligence of the Foundation, or other persons and companies known or unknown, or of willful or criminal conduct of third parties. I am also aware that medical services or facilities may not be readily available or accessible during some or all of the time during which I am participating on the trip. I voluntarily assume all risks associated with my participation. I release and discharge the Riley Orton Foundation, its officers, directors, employees, and volunteers from any and all claims, liabilities, and damages arising out of or in connection with my participation in the volunteer trip, including but not limited to personal injury, property damage, and wrongful death.

Travel Insurance

All volunteers are advised to take their own travel insurance to provide coverage against cancellation, personal accident, death, medical expenses and emergency repatriation. We also strongly recommend that it covers curtailment, personal liability and loss of luggage and personal effects. The volunteer acknowledges that the cost of the trip does not include insurance, and that the volunteer is advised to obtain separate coverage at an additional cost.

Personal Responsibility & Dismissal From Trip

I agree to act responsibly and follow all instructions and guidelines provided by the Riley Orton Foundation and its representatives. I will respect local laws, customs, and cultural practices. The Foundation retains the right to dismiss a volunteer for intimidating, threatening, or illegal behaviors or activities such as Illegal or Illicit Substance Use and Intimidating or Threatening Behaviors. The foundation is not responsible for any costs incurred as a result, including, but not limited to, costs for medical care and court/incarceration proceedings. Any costs incurred by the foundation as a result of these activities are the sole responsibility of the volunteer, and the foundation will invoice the volunteer for immediate payment.

Photographic release and Voluntary Execution

I grant the Riley Orton Foundation permission to use photographs and videos taken during the volunteer trip for promotional and educational purposes without compensation.
